



Colonel Erica L. Kane graduated from the University of Notre Dame with a bachelor's degree in psychology and commissioned in the Medical Service Corps in 2005 as a Distinguished Military Graduate. She earned a Master of Public Administration in Emergency Management and Homeland Security from George Mason University in 2015 and Master of Arts in National Security and Strategic Studies from the U.S. Naval War College in 2025.

COL Kane's assignments include the Executive Officer (XO) of the 772d Forward Surgical Team and deployed to Baghdad, Iraq for OIF 05-07.

Following her return, she was the Adjutant for the 86th Combat Support Hospital (CSH). She deployed as the Task Force 86 Mosul S3 to Forward Operating Base Diamondback, Iraq during OIF 07-09 and returned to serve as the Operations Officer for the 86th CSH. COL Kane commanded Charlie Company, 24th Brigade Support Battalion (BSB), 170th Infantry Brigade Combat Team (IBCT), Baumholder, Germany and deployed in support of OEF 11-12 to Afghanistan. She assumed duty as BN XO for the 24th BSB during the inactivation of the 170th IBCT and transitioned to the S3 for the 16th Special Troops Battalion (Prov). COL Kane was the Support Operations Officer and XO of the 56th Multifunctional Medical Battalion at Joint Base Lewis-McChord. From 2018 to 2020, she served as the Chief of Current Operations with the Office of The Surgeon General/U.S. Army Medical Command and then as the Executive Assistant to the OTSG/MEDCOM Chief of Staff. She served as the Medical Organizational Integrator with HQDA, G-3/5/7 Force Management at the Pentagon from 2020-2022. She commanded the U.S. Army Health Clinic in Wiesbaden, Germany from 2022-2024. Most recently, she served as the OTSG/MEDCOM Director of Public Affairs.
