

To Start an Enrollment Package

Only for dependents with a special medical and/or educational need. Enrollment criteria can be found in DODI 1315.19.

- 1. **Sponsor** must login into the E-EFMP website via CAC at efmp.army.mil. Use Google Chrome.
- 2. From the home page, start a new package. Select Start an Enrollment.
- 3. Read over and accept the Purpose & Disclosure agreement. Click Acknowledge & Continue.
- 4. Select **EFMP ENROLLMENT** from the drop-down box.
- 5. Next you will enter your supervisor's and commander's email addresses and your demographics.
- 6. Select the Family Member you are enrolling in EFMP and click Continue.
- 7. Answer several questions about this Family Member. Once completed, select Save & Continue.
- 8. Read over the DD 2792 Privacy Act Statement and check accept. Click Continue to proceed.
- 9. Read over the Authorization for Disclosure of Medical Information and check I accept below.
- 10. Digitally Sign and select Submit.
- 11. If enrolling an adult Family Member, the package will be routed to that individual to sign a HIPAA release using their DS Login online at <a href="effective-eff-nc-ef
- 12. Upon submission and at each step, every package is routed automatically to its next step. Log in frequently to efmp.army.mil to track your package along the process.

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- Adult Family Members will need a DS Login to access E-EFMP and sign HIPAA release. Need a DS Logon? Acquire one here: https://myaccess.dmdc.osd.mil/identitymanagement/app/login
- Medical enrollment packages will come back to the Soldier or adult Family Member for a final review of all
 information including diagnoses, medications, and required care on the electronic DD Form 2792. Please review
 carefully for accuracy <u>prior</u> to signing.
